Introduction

The American Red Cross is a charitable not-for-profit organization dedicated to providing service to those in need, The American Red Cross has traditionally demanded and received the highest ethical performance from its volunteers and paid staff. In an effort to maintain the high standard of conduct expected and deserved by the American public and to enable the organization to continue to offer services required by those in need. The American Red Cross operates under the following Code of Conduct, applicable to all volunteers and paid staff.

Code of Conduct

No volunteer or paid staff member shall:

- a. Authorize the use of or use for the benefit or advantage of any person, the name, emblem, endorsement, services, or property of the American Red Cross.
- b. Accept or seek, on behalf of any other person; any financial advantage or gain of the other than nominal value which may be offered as a result of the volunteer's or paid staff's affiliation with the American Red Cross.
- c. Publicly utilize any American Red Cross affiliation in connection with the promotion of partisan politics, religious matter, or positions on any issue not in conformity with the official position of the American Red Cross.
- d. Disclose any confidential American Red Cross information that is available solely as a result of the volunteer's or paid staff member's affiliation with the American Red Cross to any person not authorized to receive such information, or use to the disadvantage of the American Red Cross any such confidential information, without express authorization of the American Red Cross.
- e. Knowingly take any action or make any statement intended to influence the conduct of the American Red Cross in such a way as to confer any financial benefit or any person, corporation, or entity in which the individual has a significant interest or affiliation.
- f. Operate or act in any manner that is contrary to the best interests of the American Red Cross.

In the event that the volunteer's or paid staff's obligation to operate in the best interest of the American Red Cross conflicts with the interest of any organization in which the individual has a financial interest or an affiliation, the individual shall disclose such conflict to the American Red Cross upon becoming aware of it, shall absent himself or herself from the room during deliberations on the matter, and shall refrain from participating in any decisions or voting in connection with the matter.
